VARIETY FEATURES

TWO-TONE PETAL COLOUR: a question of day-length and temperature



- Average-day:Even proportion of colour and white
- Flowering: mid-autumn/winter
 - Long-day: The colour prevails
 - Flowering: spring/summer/early autumn
 - Short-day:
 The white prevails
 - Flowering: winter

In a cool climate: the intensity of the INDIAKA® varieties' white/colour contrast depends on the temperature; the colder it is, the more intense the colour contrast.

For good two-tone petal colour, <u>plan your sales period from October.</u> (Southern Hemisphere plan from April-May)

On average, we count around 2% of straight colours, beginning of flowering.
